



Sports Premium Funding Statement

At Woodgate Primary School, we are committed to promoting healthy lifestyles and ensuring all pupils have access to high-quality physical education and sporting opportunities. The PE and Sport Premium funding has played a vital role in enhancing our provision and supporting whole-school improvement.

Funding Overview

In the 2024–2025 academic year, our school received £19,570 in PE and Sport Premium funding. This funding was allocated across several key areas to support staff development, pupil engagement, and resource enhancement.

Spending Breakdown

Staff CPD (Continuing Professional Development):

- External training courses: £225
- Focused on improving staff confidence and competence in delivering PE lessons.

Internal Activities:

- Extra-curricular opportunities: £6,380
- Equipment and resources: £12,741

These investments have expanded the range of physical activities available to pupils and improved the quality of PE lessons.

External Activities:

- No spending was allocated to external activities this year.

Impact of Funding

The funding has had a positive impact across multiple areas:

- Increased staff confidence, knowledge, and skills in teaching PE.
- Greater pupil engagement in regular physical activity and sport.
- Raised the profile of PE and sport across the school.
- Broader and more equal access to a range of sports and physical activities.
- Increased participation in competitive sport and extra-curricular activities.
- Improved PE attainment and physical activity levels among pupils.



Swimming and Water Safety

Year 6 Cohort Swimming Proficiency:

- 35% can swim 25 metres confidently.
- 35% can use a range of strokes effectively.
- 100% can perform safe self-rescue in water-based situations.

Sustainability

The improvements made through the funding are sustainable and continue to benefit pupils and staff. We remain committed to embedding physical activity into our school culture and curriculum.
